Classes IX to XII

Preparing Students for Excellence, Independence and the Future

At MPS International, the Senior Section marks an important transition in a student's educational journey. Classes IX to XII are not viewed only as preparation for board examinations and higher education; they are years in which students develop deeper subject understanding, independent thinking, confidence, discipline and the ability to make informed choices about their future.

As a CBSE-affiliated school, our academic programme is aligned with the CBSE curriculum, NCERT learning framework and the vision of NEP 2020. Our approach combines strong academic foundations with experiential, competency-based, technology-enabled and student-centred learning.

Our Academic Philosophy

We believe that education should move beyond remembering information to understanding, applying, analysing and creating.

Our teachers therefore use a blend of:

- Concept-based and competency-based learning
- Experiential and activity-based learning
- Inquiry and problem-based learning
- Project and research-based learning
- Collaborative and peer learning
- Discussion, debate and presentation
- Art-integrated and sports-integrated learning
- Digital and technology-enabled learning
- Self-directed and reflective learning
- Real-life application of concepts

The focus is on developing students who can **think critically, communicate effectively, collaborate confidently, solve problems creatively and use knowledge responsibly**.

This approach is consistent with NEP 2020's emphasis on experiential learning, critical thinking, creativity, competency development and holistic education.

Classes IX & X – Building Strong Foundations (create hyperlink and on click display matter)

Classes IX and X provide students with a strong academic foundation while preparing them for the CBSE Board Examination.

Learning at this stage focuses on:

Conceptual clarity: Students are encouraged to understand the "why" and "how" behind concepts rather than rely only on memorisation.

Competency development: Classroom tasks require students to apply concepts to unfamiliar and real-life situations.

Experiential learning: Laboratory work, projects, demonstrations, field-based activities, discussions and practical tasks connect classroom learning with the world around students.

Communication and collaboration: Presentations, group activities, debates and peer learning help students develop confidence and communication skills.

Technology integration: Smart classrooms, digital resources, computer facilities, Google Workspace and the school's ATAL Lab provide opportunities for students to use technology as a tool for learning, exploration and innovation.

Subjects

The curriculum at Classes IX and X includes the prescribed CBSE academic subjects, along with opportunities for Art Education, Health & Physical Education and Work Experience as applicable under the CBSE framework. Language options and other subjects are offered as per the school's approved subject structure for the academic session.

Assessment in Classes IX & X

Assessment is designed to measure not only what students know but also how well they understand and apply their learning.

Students are assessed through a combination of:

- Periodic and school-based assessments
- Competency-based questions
- Classwork and assignments
- Projects and practical activities
- Subject-specific laboratory work
- Presentations and collaborative tasks
- Portfolio/reflection-based activities, wherever appropriate
- Term/annual examinations
- Internal assessment components prescribed by CBSE

Students receive regular feedback so that assessment becomes a part of learning rather than simply a measure at the end of learning.

For Class IX, the CBSE assessment framework follows the broad pattern of the Class X Board Examination, with the prescribed grading structure.

Classes XI & XII – Choice, Depth and Career Readiness (create hyperlink and on click display matter)

Classes XI and XII are a period of academic specialisation and preparation for higher education and future careers.

Students are guided to make informed subject choices based on their interests, abilities, aspirations and future pathways. The school offers academic pathways in accordance with its approved CBSE subject combinations and available courses.

The senior secondary curriculum provides opportunities for students to pursue languages along with academic and/or skill-based electives as permitted within the CBSE scheme of studies. Students selecting subjects in Class XI are expected to continue the same subjects in Class XII. CBSE prescribes a minimum of five subjects for the senior secondary course, subject to the applicable scheme of studies. **[Click here to view the subjects and streams offered at MPS International, Jaipur]**
