We brought together experts from various fields and leading universities across the country under one roof to conduct sessions tailored to the interests of students. It is widely acknowledged that a child's career should be built upon their strengths, limitations, interests, and inherent dispositions. Therefore, choosing a career is not merely about selecting a profession but also about understanding the potential for growth and success within that chosen path. Identifying a child's aptitude and interests can be difficult, particularly in an environment where ambitions are often overshadowed by fleeting fascinations. Even when a child's aptitude is clearly understood, there are numerous factors to consider before making a decision. These can range from the child's personal interests, family aspirations, and financial considerations to the long-term viability and scope of the chosen career path.

The Education Committee of the Maheshwari Samaj, Jaipur, is set to conduct an Online Career Assessment Test for students in Classes IX and X. This test serves as a pivotal element in our comprehensive Counselling Program, designed to address individual challenges and provide clarity on the ideal career paths for both students and their parents. The Career Counselling Program (CAP), developed and administered by expert psychologists and certified counsellors, offers personalised guidance tailored to each student's unique strengths and aspirations. This initiative aims to support students and their parents in Grades IX and X by helping them make informed decisions about future academic and career choices. The program includes the following key components:

Online Career Assessment Test –A unique combination of Personality, Aptitude and Career Interest test (based upon most recent parameters of testing the skills and abilities) which will help students to identify the right stream, course, and career selection in accordance with their personality and abilities in a short span of 1hour 16 minutes.

Graphical and Detailed Report Card – that showcases the student's unique personality traits, aptitude score and career interest area.

Personal Counselling of students and parents will address the following: -

- 1. Assess academic performance and potential
- Analyze strengths and weaknesses of the student based on the CAP Test
- 3. Provide details of various career options and how to make smart career choices
- 4. Guidance on suitable stream selection with various subject combinations
- 5. Address any issue faced by young adults
- 6. Resolve the confusion and conflicts due to the plethora of career choices
- 7. Help cope with pressure leading to improved mental health
- Provide genuine comprehensive information with experienced and Certified counsellors
- 9. Empower every parent to help their child to unlock their true potential.

The above test will be conducted free of cost for all the students however the society will bear the cost of the test per child to the tune of Rs. 250/- (inclusive of Test + Comprehensive Report). The detailed report in soft copy will be provided to the individual student.

Personal Career Counselling Session will allow you to satisfactorily take a decision about your ward's career.

It is highly advisable for parents to accompany their ward at the time of the counselling session. With dedicated slots per student, the counsellor is available for nuanced discussion without the usual time constraints.

The above Personal Career Counselling Session will be optional and will attract an amount of Rs. 500/- (where a one-to-one session of 45 minutes will be provided).

Please note that the subject stream selection of your ward will depend on the cut off specified for each stream. The result of this career assessment test will not have any bearing on the stream allotted by the school.
